
3-Day International Conference Cum Workshop on "Natural Products: Biological and Pharmaceutical Applications"














Through My Eyes: GCWUF Faculty Showcase Artistic Excellence at Punjab Arts Council

The session provided Ph.D. scholars with valuable insights into ethical and methodological aspects of clinical research, promoting advanced academic understanding.









Dr. Ayesha Younus and Dr. Nayyab Mansoor Represent GCWUF at Global Food Research Forum




GCWUF Successfully Concludes Women Empowerment and Mentorship Program (WEMP) under HEC's HEDP Initiative


GCWUF Observes International Climate Action Day with Sustainability Week


GCWUF Observes International Climate Action Day with Sustainability Week



GCWUF Students Unite for Kashmir Solidarity Day














Celebration of International Pi Day with Creativity and Learning

GCWUF Hosts Nutrition Awareness Session at Shiblee College


